



JANUARY COVID PLAN

Following yesterday's announcement from public health stating restrictions will be extended until **January 31st 2022** dancers can expect to see some minor changes in effect after their return to classes on January 13th.



- Masks will be mandatory at ALL TIMES while inside the facility, this includes in the lobby, washroom and during class time. Dancers without a mask will not be permitted to enter the studio.



- Physical distancing will be required during dance classes (where the group is larger than 9 participants). When dancers enter the facility, they will sanitize and then head directly to the studio where they will be required to stand on a pre-marked yellow square. This will be their designated 6-foot space for the duration of class.
- We encourage dancers to bring a water bottle with them to their space and use the washroom before/after rehearsal to avoid crossing paths with other dancers.

There will be a few 'off limit' areas during this time as we cannot guarantee physical distancing. These areas include:



- The main lobby. We ask that dancers eat before/after rehearsal time (outside the facility) as we are not permitted to remove our masks for a prolonged period of time.
- The water fountain. However our refillable water bottle station will be available to dancers.
- The large washrooms in Studio 2. We ask that dancers use the individual washroom in the hallway instead.



As we anticipate that some dancers may need to isolate during this time, we will be live-streaming all of our classes via zoom to ensure no one is missing any dance time. We ask that dancers contact the office if they are required to isolate, are experiencing any covid symptoms, or simply do not feel comfortable returning at this time. We will be happy to send you our live-stream link. Dancers participating via zoom will not be required to have their camera on, although it is encouraged!
